

Death by Chocolate Pumpkin Muffin by Sarah Graves



All Hallows by Christopher Golden

In "All Hallows," bestselling author Christopher Golden delivers a horror drama set on Halloween night in 1984, Coventry, Massachusetts. As two families face unraveling secrets, four eerie children in vintage costumes appear, seeking refuge from a lurking evil known as The Cunning Man. Amidst neighborhood tensions, the children plead for protection. Golden combines supernatural elements with suburban themes, creating a chilling tale where masks hide true horrors.



Not Quite Dead Yet by Holly Jackson

In this twisty thriller, Jet Mason, a 27-year-old from a wealthy Woodstock family, faces imminent death after a Halloween night attack leaves her with a severe head injury. With just seven days to live, she reevaluates her relationships, suspecting those around her—including family and friends. Determined to solve her own murder before it's too late, she relies on her childhood friend, Billy, for support as her condition worsens.



Home at Night by Paula Munier

In Vermont during Halloween, Mercy Carr's cramped cabin is filled with five humans, two dogs, and a cat. She seeks more space at Grackle Tree Farm, a Victorian manor rumored to be haunted. When her dog Elvis discovers a dead body in the library, Mercy uncovers a coded letter hinting at hidden treasure. As she and Captain Thrasher investigate, they encounter a masked man who shoots Thrasher, leaving him hospitalized and Mercy injured. Now, with her team and the dogs, Mercy must hunt down the murderer amidst Halloween festivities and treasure hunters to protect Grackle Tree Farm's reputation and secure the treasure.

Ty and Heather Moon convert their Victorian home into a haunted house for charity, but things go awry when Heather overdoses on tainted drugs, leading to Ty's murder accusation. Journalist Lucy Stone investigates, revealing sinister secrets tied to a conspiracy in her hometown.


